The Southern Gulf Islands Arts Council is organizing a regional art show entitled “Arts on the Islands” this summer that will bring together art and artists from four island communities: Mayne, Galiano, Pender and Saturna.

Artworks will be displayed in a 10-day juried exhibition in the Mayne Island Agricultural Hall from June 26 to July 5, 2020 and in an online exhibition made available through technical assistance from the Federation of Canadian Artists. A printed catalogue of artists’ work will be published and prizes, including a people’s choice award, will be presented.

This exhibition will bring together the islands’ talented artists and showcase the work they create. Artists at all stages of their careers, from emerging to established, are being encouraged to participate. Often artists pay to exhibit their work but there will be no fees for Arts on the Islands.

The organizing team is experienced in organizing shows, events and festivals, and is hopeful “Arts on the Islands” will be the first of many such exhibitions and that it’s the beginning of a lasting legacy. However, to achieve our goals, we need your help.
