Following the meeting we will be joined by **historian Jennifer Iredale for a journey through an illustrated history of the Georgina Point Lighthouse, the new home of the Southern Gulf Islands Arts Council!**

Known variously as Plumper Pass Light-station, Georgina Point Lighthouse and Active Pass Lighthouse, this is probably the most photographed place on Mayne Island— and the new home of the SGIAC. Join historian Jennifer Iredale for a journey through an illustrated history of the Lighthouse.

Jennifer, who makes her home in Victoria and Mayne Island, is the former curator of provincial heritage properties such as Barkerville and Emily Carr House, and the retired Director of the provincial Heritage Branch. In the past decade she has focussed on research and writing about history related to our island and the Fraser Canyon. She has been well recognized for her work; most recently receiving the BC Historical Federations Best Article award in 2023. Jennifer is an active volunteer on Mayne Island including providing her curatorial expertise to the Mayne Island Museum. She will draw on her work at the Museum for this presentation.
